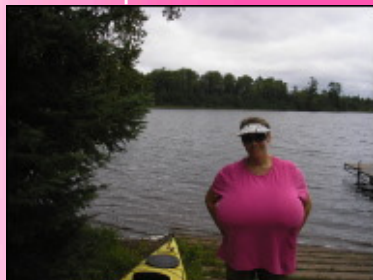

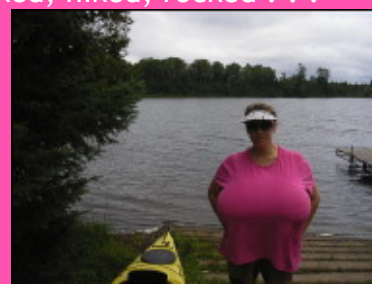
July 1 - August 25

an open fire. The first night up there proved to be very cold, but the rest were very nice.

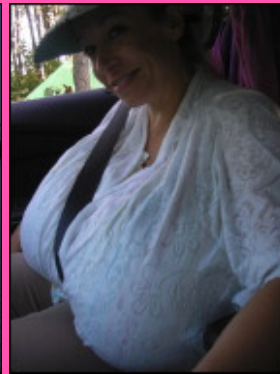
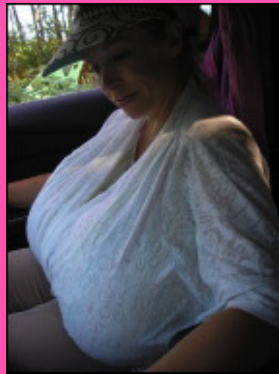
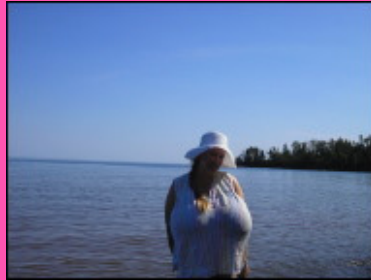
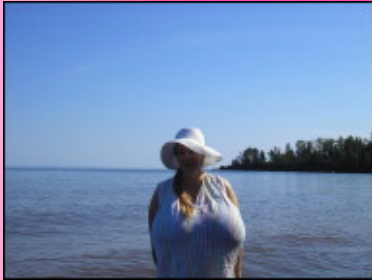
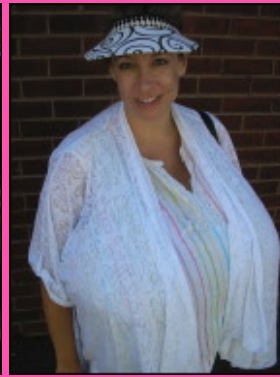

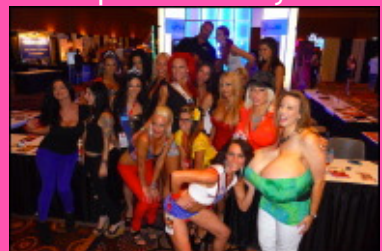


August 26 - 31

Minnesota club owner I got my start with) and so many more! There's lots of beautiful people in Vegas to enjoy! And enjoy

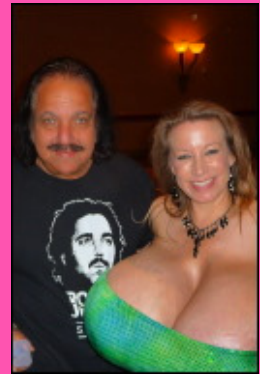
