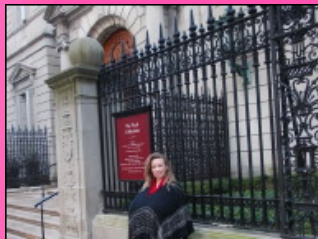

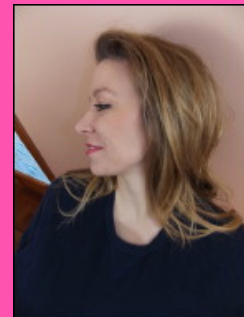

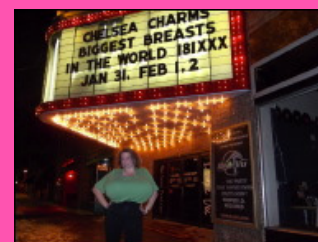


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January 31 - February 14

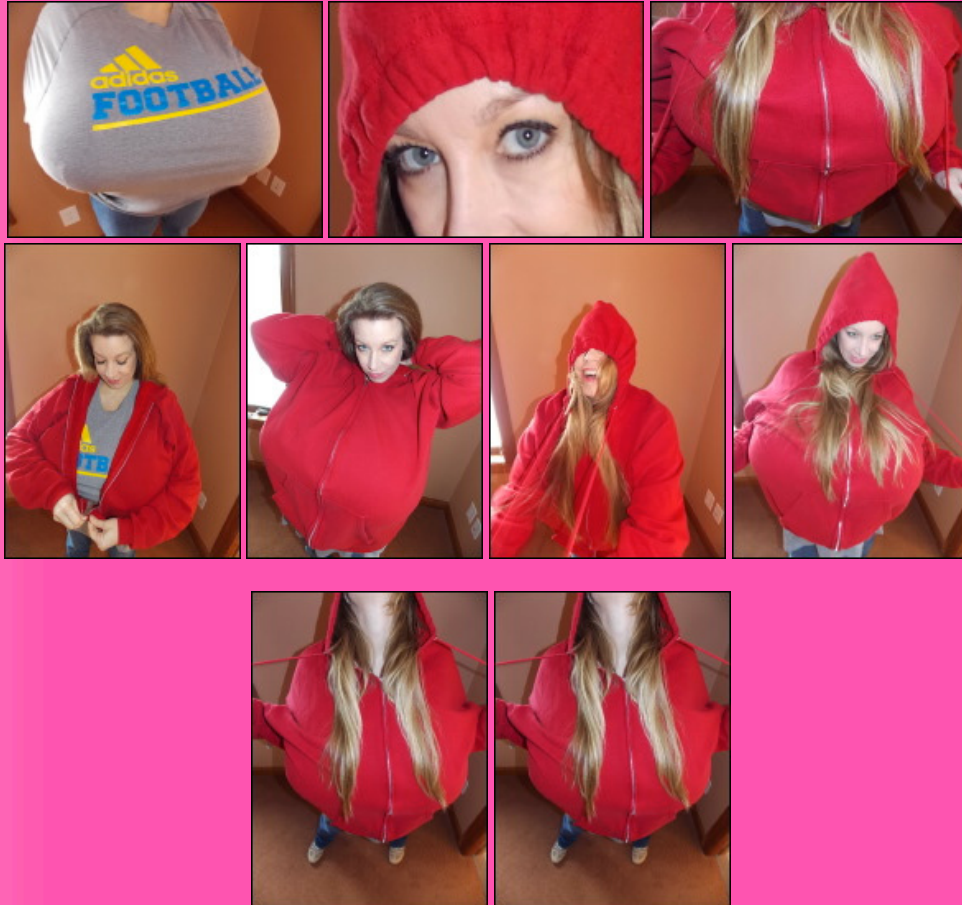


(those neat new commercials and the power outage during the game kept everybody attentive) and had a great time.
